On a motion made by Commissioner Faller and second by Commissioner Campbell that all county elected officials receive the same percentage of yearly wage increase as the county non-union employees receive from year 2018 through 2023, *excluding* the District Attorney, the Judge of the County Court of Common Pleas, District Judges, (all of whose salaries are set by the state) and the county tax collectors. The increase shall not exceed 3 percent in any given year.

On a motion made by Commissioner Faller and second by Commissioner Campbell that county tax collectors receive a raise to \$4 per real estate tax collection beginning in the year 2022 with per capita to remain at \$1.50 per collection.

Scott Seeley asked for clarification of the year that the elected official’s salary schedule would take place. It will begin in 2018.
