AN EMERGENCY WORK ORDER**


**BE IT RESOLVED,**

On Friday, September 9, 2016, following a heavy rain storm that overwhelmed an internal drain pipe to the gutter system on the roof of the old county jail water leaked into the hallway of the 911 Emergency Operations Center. In an effort to ensure the safety of 911 equipment and employees the County Commissioners issued an emergency work order with Keystone Enviro Vac Services, of Crown, to correct any drainage problems and clean areas affected by rain water infiltration.

This Resolution shall be retroactive to September 12, 2016, and shall remain in place until all corrective action has been completed.


