For all parents of minor children filing an action in Clarion County that involves family issues

This program covers:

The effects of family separation on children
Parenting arrangements to fit children's needs
Pitfalls—putting children in the middle
Conflict resolution and problem solving

Registration

Attendance is required within 60 days of the date of filing for both parties and their school-aged children.

Fee of \$40 per adult must be paid prior to attendance,

payable in cash or money order only.

Pre-registration is recommended and required for all PFA actions. Seating is limited to 17 participants.

Voluntary Participation

If attendance is prior to the filing of any action with the Court, the fee is \$30.

Proof of Attendance: Certificates of attendance will be presented to participants at the end of the program. The Program staff will provide documentation to the Court of successful completion. Certificates/Court documentation will not be issued for those who miss more than 15 minutes of the program.

Childcare is not provided. Parents cannot bring children to the parent program.

Parents can attend separately or together unless there is a PFA in effect. In that case, the parent who registers and pays first will attend that session.
