The National Weather Service (NWS) and the Clarion County Department of Public Safety has again partnered together to present a SKYWARN Observer training class, in Clarion County.

SKYWARN is a group of trained severe weather spotters that report directly to the National Weather Service.

Year after year, reports from SKYWARN observers have assisted the NWS in issuing timely warnings based on real-time reports throughout the 36 counties of Pittsburgh's County Warning Area.

The primary mission of the NWS is to issue warnings to protect life and property.

This class is open to the public and is FREE. Also, there is no age limit.
