

**RESOLUTION NO. 4 OF 2015
COUNTY OF CLARION
PROPOSED REVISION TO THE FFY 2011 CDBG PROGRAM**

A resolution by the Clarion County Commissioners approving a REVISION to the County's FFY 2011 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program and authorizing the filing of the REVISION with the Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development (DCED).

WHEREAS, the County of Clarion is the recipient of a grant from the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania under the Pennsylvania CDBG Program for the fiscal year 2011; and

WHEREAS, the County of Clarion has proposed a REVISION to its FFY 2011 CDBG Program; and

WHEREAS, the Strattanville Sidewalk Replacement Project and the Knox Curb Ramp Project have been completed without expending all the funds assigned to those projects, and the Hawthorn Redbank Redbank Municipal Authority (HRRMA) – New Sewer Lateral Project is still an open project under the FFY 2013 CDBG Program and additional funds are needed; and


WHEREAS, the revision will cause the following unexpended funds from these projects to be re-assigned to the HRRMA New Sewer Lateral Project;

2011 KNOX BOROUGH - NEW CURB RAMPS PROJECT	\$4,173.35
2011 STRATTANVILLE BOROUGH - SIDEWALK REPLACEMENT PROJECT	\$1,529.88



The purpose of this letter is to request a reallocation of funds as shown below.

Revision Request #2015 – 001

This request is for the transfer of funding from two completed projects (Knox Curb Ramp Project and the Strattanville Sidewalk Replacement Project) into the Hawthorn Redbank Redbank Municipal Authority (HRRMA) New Sewer Lateral Project. This is a current open project under FFY 2013 CDBG Program.

Both completed projects came in under budget, and beneficiaries and scope of work remain the same. If approved, this revision will decrease the original approved activity funds for the Knox and Strattanville Projects and increase the funding for the HRRMA New Sewer Lateral Project. The details of the revision being requested may be found on the attached table.

The justification for this revision request is: When all invoices on the two projects were paid, there were remaining unspent funds allocated to the projects.

Enclosed are the following documents as required for revisions:

- a) Two Revised Activity Descriptions (Knox and Strattanville);
- b) One New Activity Description (Hawthorn-New Project for FFY 2011), including

- Project Budget and Project Completion Timetable.
- c) Revised Budget Summary (no OBO Projects were affected).
 - d) Revised LMI Principal Benefit Determination.
 - e) Date of Environmental Clearance - August 29, 2012, Contract Number C000052196 (FFY 2011) for initial clearance. ERR is currently ongoing for the Hawthorn Project.
 - f) Approved Resolution No. 4 by the County of Clarion authorizing the two revisions.

It is agreed that all other provisions and certifications of the Grant Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
