A Resolution of the County of Clarion, Pennsylvania adopting a budget and fixing the tax rates for the year 2012 and thereafter until taxing rate changes.

BE IT RESOLVED, Clarion County anticipates revenues for the 2012 taxing year for the purpose of county government expenditures.

BE IT RESOLVED, Clarion County prepared and adopted a budget on December 22, 2011 to include the following taxing information.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, Clarion County tax levy for the year 2012.

*A tax rate for general revenue purposes, the sum of 20 mills on assessed valuation and 1 mill for debt service. Per capita tax at a rate of \$5.00 per individual residing within the County of Clarion.


*Discounts and penalty: at the following rate of 2% for discount and 5% for penalty.


*Hotel Room Excise Tax adopted May 25, 2004 at a rate of 3%.
